

Showcase Camp: Individual Player and Team event (Boys and Girls U14-U18)

About the Player ID Camp: *The Player ID Camp is brought to you by Rated Sports, organizers of Canada's largest soccer showcase, the [Umbro Top Rated Showcase](#); in conjunction with Edmonton Archbishop O'Leary High School and the Calgary South West United S.C. The showcase camp is open to both boys and girls ages. Due to NCAA regulations, acceptance to the ID camp is based on first come first serve acceptance and does not require a tryout to be selected for the camp. All players receive equal playing time during showcase games.*

Player ID Camp Program Highlights:

Two day camp: Half day instruction and half day 11v11 showcase games in front of University and College coaches, to showcase players' abilities for scholarship recruitment purposes.

10:1 Player to Instructor ratio: Players are grouped into a team of 10 players (field players and goalies separated). Each team will be together for the two day camp. Teams will be identified by their jersey colour and player number. The university and college instructors will have a team roster with each player's pertinent information.

Training with University Instructors: Players will train with 3 NCAA, NAIA, CIS instructors per day

Full 11 v 11 Showcase games: Three (3) games/ day (30 minute games). All eyes on the players (no training occurring at this time).

University and College instructors: Instructors represent educational institutions from private and public Universities and Colleges: National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA Division I, II, III), the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA), and the Canadian Interuniversity Sport (CIS)

Educational Aspect: University and College coach discussion/ Q&A with players and parents to learn the rules and regulations of the NCAA, NAIA and CIS, university life, and what it takes to be a student athlete at the post secondary level.

Discount Club Offer:

Option #1:

- Step 1: All players are to complete the "online registration" and use the "mail-in payment form" attaching a cheque for the full fee of \$250.
- Step 2: Once full documentation has been received, a cheque will be sent to the team/club for a reimbursement to players or team accounts.

Option #2:

- Step 1: All players are to complete the "online registration" and make full payment of \$250 with credit card at time of online registration.
- Step 2: Registration will be tracked and discounts will be issued directly to the registrants' credit card.

*Note: payment online is subject to a 4% service fee and this will be deducted from discount listed above.

Option #3:

- Step 1: Team coaches have players' complete registration online (without submitting the online payment).
- Step 2: Team coaches and managers are responsible for collecting camp entry fees based on the discount above (i.e. \$25 or \$50 deducted from entry fee of \$250).

Notes:

- Provincial players attending ASA training camp on July 5th have the option to attend the ID camp for one day on July 4th.
- Hotels are available for players starting from \$25/ player per night. Please call one of the co-ordinators below to request.
